



Village of Osceola Seasonal (Temporary Worker)

GENERAL DEFINITION OF WORK: Performs semi-skilled work of parks, buildings, equipment and grounds for proper maintenance and safety of park facilities, equipment and grounds. Work is performed under regular supervision. Safety is paramount.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS/TYPICAL TASKS: Performing a variety of semi-skilled tasks in the maintenance of parks, buildings grounds and streets. Maintains park facilities, such as picnic shelters, playground areas and public buildings; Operates and maintains vehicles and equipment used to perform maintenance assignments; Operates and maintains power and hand tools; Performs maintenance practices such as tree planting, mowing, trimming, weeding, garbage collection and bathroom cleaning; Assists in the construction of park facilities and active play areas such as playground structures, backstops, retaining walls; Assists in street maintenance, right-of-way clearing, and painting; Performs related tasks as required.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: General knowledge of the construction, maintenance and repair of parks, buildings, grounds and landscaping areas; general knowledge of the safe use, operation and preventive maintenance of the equipment to which assigned; skill in the use of equipment to which assigned; ability to understand and follow specific oral instructions; ability to perform manual labor for extended periods, often under unfavorable weather conditions; good physical condition; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with associates, staff and the general public.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: Requires reading, communication and problems solving skills equivalent to high school.

CONDITIONS OF WORK: This is heavy work requiring up to the exertion of 100 pounds of force occasionally, up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and up to 20 pounds of force constantly to move objects; work requires climbing, balancing, stooping, reaching, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, and grasping; vocal communication is required for expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word; hearing is required to perceive information at normal spoken word levels; assembly or fabrication of parts at or within arm's length, operation of machines, operation of motor vehicles or equipment, and observing general surroundings and activities; the worker is subject to inside and outside environmental conditions, extreme cold, extreme heat, noise, vibration, hazards and oils.

REQUIREMENTS: Must be 16 years of age and in possession of an appropriate valid driver's license.
