Bottles, Cans & Jars:



* Plastic #1 & #2 & Glass Bottles & Jars & Aluminum, Aerosol, Tin Cans (lightly rinsed). Labels/caps can be left on. Dbl rinse automotive, herbicide & pesticide bottles.
* No: dishes, cookware, bulbs, window glass, aluminum foil etc..

Paper:



* Newspaper, Magazines, Junk Mail, Glossy Flyers, Phone Books, Office Paper (any color), Envelopes
* Large amounts of WHITE paper can be placed in a bag.
*No: hard cover books, wrapping paper, greeting cards etc..

Cardboard:



* Flattened Brown Corrugated, Cereal & Cake Boxes, Cardboard Egg Cartons, Brown Paper Bags
* No: waxed refrigerated boxes or cartons, detergent, produce, pop, beer, toothpaste, soap boxes etc..

Do No Bag Recyclables
