Required qualifications include:

- High School Diploma or Equivalent
- Valid Wisconsin driver's license with no more than 3 moving violations in the past 5 years.
- Ability to obtain Water Operators Grade 1 Certification, Subclass D-Distribution and G-Groundwater within two years of hire.
- Ability to obtain Wastewater Basic Certification, Subclass A1- Suspended Growth, B- Solids Separation, C- Biological Solids/Sludge, P-Total Phosphorous, D- Disinfection, SS- Collection System or other subclasses required by the DNR within two years of hire.
- Possess a high level of mechanical aptitude and ability to troubleshoot and understand complex systems and perform maintenance and repairs on process equipment.
- Ability to read and interpret maps, blueprints, and schematics.
- Ability to read, write, and speak professionally in a forward-facing role.
